



WAILING WOMEN WORLDWIDE USA PRAYER FOCUS FOR MAY 2023

SCRIPTURE READING: Read one chapter a day from the book of Psalms 101-131. See the reading schedule on page 4.

PRAISE AND WORSHIP:

The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. The LORD is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee. Psalm 145:8-10

REPENTANCE

- Ask for forgiveness where you have used blame, coverups, and rationalization for sin.
- Ask the Holy Spirit for heightened sensitivity to all ungodliness and willingness to heed His warnings.
- Pray for that the church will turn around and head back to God and His kingdom precepts.

CHURCH

- Let us pray that the church will awaken with the spirit of boldness and passionately seek to rescue the perishing, the suffering, the battered, the hopeless, the devastated, and the distressed to the glory of God.
- Let us ask the Lord to kindle fresh fire of revival in the Church, that the people will be delivered from the burden of sicknesses and challenges and bring lasting healing to deliverance.

CONFERENCE

- Pray for God's direction for our leaders and conference planning committee, that they will hear the Lord clearly and execute the will of God.
- Commit our upcoming national conference to the hands of the Lord for divine provision of funds, passages (transportation, visas, attendees, speakers etc.). Let the Spirit of God lead and go before us.

GOVERNMENT

- Appeal to the Lord for a spiritual move in the US government that will turn the hearts of our leaders to God and that our elected officials will see issues from God's perspective and work in unity towards the good of the masses they represent.
- Lord, please protect America from any bill that will make us lose or negatively impact our sovereignty. Pray that nations will not allow WHO to take sovereignty over healthcare.
- Pray against any ungodly agenda to cause another pandemic for population control. Let God expose such plans and put confusion into their midst (Isaiah 44:25; Psalm 140:8).

FAMILY

- Let us thank God for the gift of our families. Pray for a fresh closeness with families.
- Pray that our children will have the fear of God, knowledge, wisdom, and understanding of God and His word.
- Pray that divine health will be the portion of our families.

NATIONS AND ISRAEL

- Let's pray that all the nations of the world will bow before the Lord. Pray for God's hand of protection upon all the nations in these days of unrest, wars, famine, and anger.
- Let us pray for the believers and missionaries that are being persecuted and their persecutors in all the nations. Pray for the leaders of the nations to rule with fear of God.
- Let us pray for God's guidance and protection over Israel. Pray also for the peace of Jerusalem according to the word of God.

PROJECTS:

- Let us pray concerning the projects the Lord has committed into our hands, the early childcare center, the prayer tower, medical projects, and others, that as we build, the Lord will strengthen our hands for these good works.
- Let us pray that the Lord Almighty will provide every resource needed to complete these projects.
