

# WAILING WOMEN WORLDWIDE USA MARCH 2024 PRAYER FOCUS

As you pray, ask God for the spirit of wailing to fall afresh upon us that there will be a burden to cry before God for our nation and the world (Jeremiah 9:17–19, 2 Samuel 14:2, Lamentations 3:49–50).

SCRIPTURE READING: Read one chapter daily from the books of 1 Timothy 1–6; 2 Timothy 1–4, and John 1–21. See reading chart on page 4.

### PRAISE AND WORSHIP

"Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name" (1 Chronicles 29:11–13).

#### REPENTANCE AND DELIVERANCE

Daniel 9:7–8 (NIV): Lord, you are righteous, but this day we are covered with shame—the people of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, both near and far, in all the countries where you have scattered us because of our unfaithfulness to you. We are covered with shame, Lord, because we have sinned against you.

- Let us humbly cry out to God, acknowledging our wrongdoings, shortcomings, and transgressions. Let's ask for mercy and forgiveness.
- Let's pray for the strength of the Holy Spirit to keep us—individuals, family, community, nation—away from sin, pleasing Him in all we do.
- Pray for deliverance from all demonic manipulations and ask God to surround us and our families with His Holy fire.

### CHURCH

- Pray for the Church against prayerlessness, compromise, worldliness, doubt and love of money.
- Pray for a Church that will be a full expression of the image of God; a vibrant Church that will
  manifest the power and presence of God.
- Pray that the Church will have the ability to stand against the wiles of the devil by putting on her full amour.

### **GOVERNMENT**

- Thank You, Lord for wisdom and protection for all who faithfully serve You in public offices. Raise up many more godly and courageous men and women to represent You in the US government.
- Pray for the protection of United States of America and all our troops from the plots of our enemies. Pray against terrorist attacks against Americans within and outside this nation.
- Lord, grant us violence-free, fair, and uncorrupted elections. Above all, give Americans
  the wisdom to choose the right candidates for all positions in the forthcoming 2024
  elections.

#### ISRAEL AND THE NATIONS

- Pray for God's kingdom to come on this earth, that the hearts of the people and leaders of nations will be open to the gospel and principles of His kingdom.
- Let's ask God to protect the defenseless, and grant justice to the oppressed in every nation.
- Let's pray that God will send forth workers to bring the gospel to the unreached in all the nations resulting in large harvest of souls.
- Let us ask God to cause the war in the Middle East to cease, and pray for the release of the hostages, and the families that are affected in this war.

#### **FAMILY**

- Give glory to God for the gift and sustenance of the family, ask that his original purpose for the family be fulfilled.
- Thresh the mountains of sexual perversion or alternative lifestyle, and addiction in the family system. Whatever is not the purpose of God for the family must not stand.
- Declare that the younger generation will be passionate about the gospel, biblical truth, and desire to fulfill God's purpose. Let's pray for the Holy Spirit's encounter, divine connections, and authentic discipleship.

- Psalm 118:19 says, "Open to me the gates of righteousness, I will go into them, and I will praise the LORD" (KJV). Let us pray that Wailing Women will go through these gates of righteousness by exhibiting the character of our Lord Jesus Christ, with fear and trembling so that we might escape the wrath of God that is coming upon the earth.
- Let us pray that every Wailing Woman will recommit to the covenant of life God made with us, that we will not serve Him in sickness and pain. Pray that by His mercy upon us the doors of untimely death be shut against WWW and their families.
- Pray for fresh fire and zeal upon all the arms of WWW: GTA, WDS, Polished Arrows, Facilitators, Wailing Widows, Men Aglow, for strength, wisdom, and new ideas to achieve the purpose of their calling.
